## PACE (Property Assessed Clean Energy)Qualifying Improvements The Florida Realtors -Addendum to Contract

At or before the time a purchaser executes a contract for the sale and purchase of any property for which a nonad valorem assessment has been levied and has an unpaid balance due, the seller <u>shall give the prospective</u> <u>purchaser a written disclosure statement</u> <u>regarding qualifying improvements</u> in the following form, which shall be set forth in the contract or a separate writing:

FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY, RENEWABLE ENERGY, OR WIND RESISTANCE. — The property being purchased is located within the jurisdiction of a local government that has placed subject to an assessment on the property pursuant to Section 163.081, Florida Statutes. The assessment is for a qualifying improvement to the property relating to energy efficiency, renewable energy, or wind resistance, and is not based on the value of the property. You are encouraged to contact the county property appraiser's office to learn more about this and other assessments that may be provided by law.

**SALE OF COMMERICAL PROPERTY**. QUALIFYING IMPROVEMENTS. - The property being purchased is subject to an assessment on the property pursuant to Section 163.082, Florida Statutes. The assessment is for a qualifying improvement to the property and is not based on the value of the property. You are encouraged to contact the property appraiser's office to learn more about this and other assessments that may be provided for by law.

In the event Buyer is obtaining a mortgage loan to purchase the Property, be advised that MOST MORTGAGE LENDERS WILL REQUIRE THE SATISFACTION OR RELEASE OF THE QUALIFYING IMPROVEMENT FINANCING FROM THE PROPERTY. Buyer to verify with the lender.
